WHAT IS KANGO?

A Kiribati Association of Non-Government Organization. It is the umbrella organization for all NGO's (Non-Government Organisations) in Kiribati and was established in 1986.

A Non-Government Organisation can be defined as an independent group of people working together to achieve a particular goal. These are including women, youth, community based organization (CBO), and other civil societies.

KANGO VISION

To work with all NGOs and Associations in the spirit of cooperation, collaboration networking and partnering in order to facilitate Human Development of the Kiribati community.

KANGO MISSION

We work with National, Regional and International organizations with the ultimate aim of improving the standard of living through good governance practices for the betterment of Kiribati community.

- \$100 membership fee (annual)
- Fill in the registration form (contact us) and attached with organization's constitution
- Hand in Complete Registration Form and approved by Executive Committee
